The General Manager, Engineering III, West Bengal Housing Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (WBHIDCO) invites bids from interested experienced, reputed, bonfied, eligible contractors who are registered as a company under the Companies Act 1956 as amended from time to time for design and construction of three smart bus passenger shelters in New Town, Kolkata under the Smart City Mission.
2. Bidding will be conducted through e tendering on the site <https://wbtenders.gov.in> following procedures in accordance with the applicable Guidelines for e-Procurement under Rules in vogue of Go WB, and is open to all Bidders from eligible source, as defined in the Bid Document.
3. The Time of Completion of the work is 90 days from date of issuance of work order.
4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from Electronic Tender Site (ETS).
5. The provisions in the Instructions to Bidders and in the General Conditions of Contract are the provisions of the Bidding Documents for the Procurement of Works.
6. Bids must be submitted in ETS in terms with bidding schedule as furnished in the Bid Data Sheet (BDS) and must be accompanied by an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD), 2% of the quoted amount may be remitted through Demand Draft / Pay Order issued from any nationalized bank in favor of the **"WBHIDCO Ltd." payable at KOLKATA** and also to be documented through e-filing. The original Demand Draft / Pay Order against tender fees, Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) or documents in support should be submitted by the successful bidder at the Office of the General Manager (Engg)-III, WB HIDCO Ltd. under sealed cover **within 5 (Five) days after opening of the financial proposal (online)**.
7. Proposals with Bids will be opened through ETS and corrigendum, notification if any will be published through the ETS at the same link only.

- a. Preparation of As Built drawing, dismantling of existing structure and clearing of site at the three (3) existing bus stands at
 - i. On Biswa Bangla Sarani in front of Coal Bhaban, Premise No-04 MAR,
Plot No-AF-III, Action Area-1A, Newtown.
 - ii. On both sides of street No. 374, near Aliah University and Hajj House in Action Area IIA, New Town
- b. Geotechnical survey of the soil at the existing bus stands sites.
- c. Preparation of architectural drawing in close resemblance with the architectural concept drawing supplied with the bid documents.
- d. Getting the architectural view approved/vetted by the concerned authority of WBHIDCO Ltd.
- e. Preparation of detail engineering drawing matching the architectural concept drawing provided in the bid document, including the foundation drawing matching the soil investigation report and getting this vetted for structural safety by the GM Engineering III, WBHIDCO Ltd.
- f. Earthwork related to the construction, provided that additional excavated earth is to be dumped at a site within New Town, Kolkata, as directed by the Engineer in Charge (EIC)
- g. R.C.C. foundation work, structural works, steel structures with specialized steel structures at ground level (exposed RCC members should have finished surfaces).
- h. Roofing Works with approved ACP sheets bend to requisite radius and curvature.
- i. Floor finishing work with approved concrete stamping.
- j. All ICT components fitting and finishing with all necessary accessories and controlling systems following appropriate government regulations.
- k. All plumbing and sanitary work including fitting of fixtures of approved make

and brand for supplying drinking water and for drainage with all fittings and connecting PHE Supply/drainage line.

- I. LED Display Units and other items for the job shall be installed all complete as per direction of EIC.
 - m. Electrification work of all kind including wiring and fitting of all fixtures all complete with approved make as per direction of EIC.
 - n. Procurement of all items and supplying them at the site of construction and getting the construction done to the satisfaction of the EIC
10. The FINANCIAL OFFER of the prospective qualified tenderer(s) will be considered only if the TECHNICAL BID of the tenderer(s) is found qualified by competent authority of West Bengal Housing Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited . The decision of the competent authority of West Bengal Housing Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited will be final and absolute in this respect. The list of Qualified Bidders will be displayed in the website.
11. In term of Finance Department, Audit Branch, Govt..of West Bengal's Notification no.4374-F(Y) dated 13 th July,2017,the bidder has to uploaded valid 15-digit Goods and service Taxpayer Identification Number (GSTN) under GST Act,2017,along with his bid. The bidder should note that bid submitted without GSTIN will be summarily rejected
12. In term of finance dept. Govt. of West Bengal G.O. no-4608-F (Y) dated 18thjuly 2018 when bid rate is 80% or less of Estimated Amount put to tender, the Bidder shall submit Additional Performance Security @ 10 % of the Tendered Amount from any Schedule Bank, before issuance of work order.
13. The Additional performance security shall be submitted in the form of Bank Guarantee from any scheduled Bank before issuance of the work order. If the bidder fails to submit the additional performance security within seven working days from the date issuance of Letter Acceptance, his earnest money will be forfeited and other necessary action as per NIT like blacklisting of the contractor, etc. may be taken. The bank Guarantee shall have to be valid up to end of the contract period and shall be renewed accordingly, if required.

Notes on Instructions to Bidders

Section I, Instructions to Bidders, provides the information necessary for Bidders to prepare responsive Bids in accordance with the requirements of the Employer. It also gives information on Bid submission, opening, and evaluation, and on the award of the Contract.

A copy of the ITB is to be attached to the Bidding Documents prepared by the Employer for reference purposes only. If the Instructions to Bidders in the Bidding Documents prepared by the Employer contain modifications from the Standard Instructions to Bidders, WBHIDCO will not consider them valid and the Standard Instructions to Bidders, as defined above, shall apply.

A copy of these Instructions to Bidders is also attached to these Bidding Documents. The Instructions to Bidders will be part of the Contract.
