The Immunity Garden has 12 varieties of medicinal plants, including bay leaves, turmeric, vasaka, neem, tulsi, ashoka, ashvagandha, guddichi and many more; and a total of 115 saplings have been planted at the site. The first sapling of the garden was planted by HIDCO Chairman during the plantation ceremony.

The Immunity Garden is also envisioned to generate livelihood for the villages adjoining New Town.
